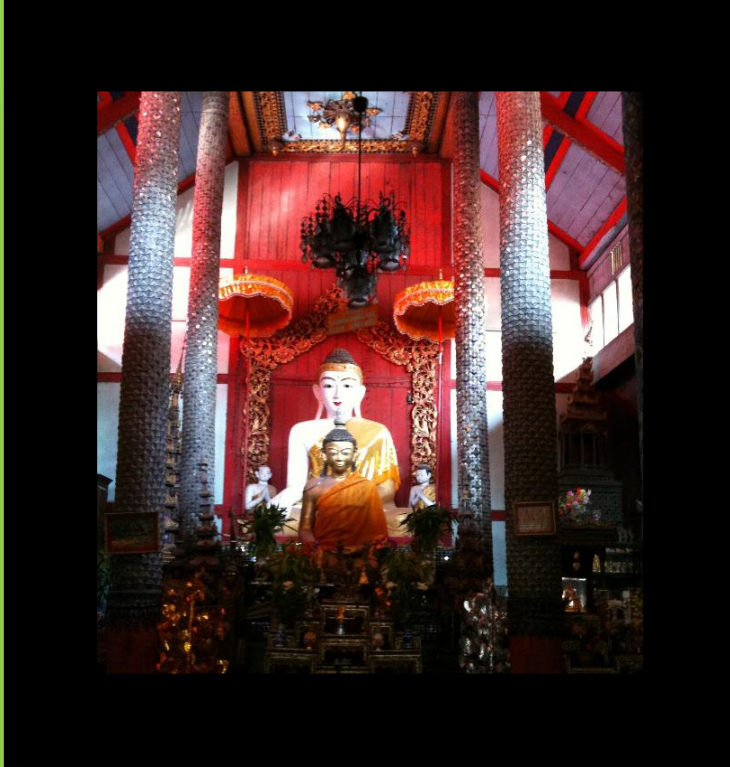


Shan Buddhism Course
